### **Holiday with a difference - with like minds**

This is our third event in the Peak District and we are returning to a venue that is perched on the edge of the Peak District with beautiful countryside and fascinating history for us to unearth. You can come for the pre-conference holiday on Wednesday 14-Friday 16 August (staying at our venue on a simple B&B basis) followed by the conference, or alternatively join us just for the conference on 17-18 August, arriving on Friday evening (16 August) so that you are ready for the start on Saturday morning.

### **Eastwood Hall: your base**



The newly refurbished venue, Eastwood Hall, is easily accessed by road and by public transport. It lies just one mile from Langley Mill station (this in turn is just 20 minutes from Nottingham station by train) and fifteen minutes by taxi from Nottingham station.

Eastwood Hall itself is a modern conference centre with indoor leisure centre with swimming pool and gym. If you are joining us for the mini-holiday and are travelling by public transport, then car sharing will be available to the places visited on 14-16 August. Here is a snapshot of some of the venues (from left to right: Hardwick Hall, Eyam (the plague village), Wollaton Hall and the Cromford Canal):



This year for our mini-holiday, we will be returning to the theme of Tartaria and asking how the buildings of Wollaton Hall and Hardwick Hall were constructed and whether Robert Smythson, dubbed Britain's first architect, really designed them. We also visit the Museum at the plague village of Eyam and ask what really caused more than a third of the inhabitants to die. Chat continues as we enjoy pub lunches and meals in picturesque but reasonably-priced eateries, and as we enjoy a cruise on the Cromford Canal *en route* to Eyam.

The conference itself will run from 10.00am on Saturday 17 August up until 5.00 pm on Sunday and the costs shown below include an overnight stay in ensuite accommodation on Friday and Saturday (both with breakfast), dinner (on Saturday), lunches (on Saturday and Sunday) as well as refreshments (hot drinks, biscuits and fruit) throughout the conference. Of course, attendance at all the talks is included in the costs.

### Costs

August is high season but we have kept costs as low as possible while providing high quality *ensuite* accommodation. The following are the Early Bird per person rates until the middle of 20 April 2024. Note that the Leisure centre can be used by all those arriving on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> August:
